

ARE YOU ELIGIBLE FOR LUNG CANCER SCREENING?



- Are you **50 to 80 years old**?

(For patients age 77-80, you may need to complete a peer-to-peer with insurance for CT scan to be authorized)

- Do you **have any signs or symptoms** of lung cancer?

(Diagnostic testing may be recommended for people who do have signs or symptoms of lung cancer)

- Have you **had lung cancer before**?

- Are you or were you a **heavy smoker**?

(20 pack-year smoking history and currently smokes)

- If a **former smoker**, have you quit within the past 15 years?

Lung cancer screening is a quick, non-invasive imaging test that can be ordered by your healthcare provider. As a preventative service endorsed by numerous professional societies, it is usually covered by insurance with little or no out of pocket expenses. Best of all, lung cancer screening saves lives by catching lung cancers that are early stage.

Vancouver Clinic has Southwest Washington's only accredited lung cancer screening program. We have comprehensive services to detect, diagnose, and treat lung cancer.
